Play Equipment. The new roundabout will be sited at Godspa - a replacement item of equipment will be provided at the new site on the Recreation Ground. The Technical Services Dept. will be pressured re sand treatment and fencing, as previously instructed.
The District Council will be asked to reinstate the vehicle gate at the Mill Yard.

Recreation Ground Football Pitch. The Town Football Club would be requested to complete the renovation of the pitch within 48 hours.

Trees. It may be necessary to purchase, in the absence of supplies from the District Council. Councillor Vane Percy would report back.

It was AGREED to purchase 4 door closers for the toilets for a sum of £200 fitted.
