As well as individual residents doing their bit, support is being coordinated by the Godmanchester Aid Group comprising the Town Council, the Godmanchester Timebank, the Food Bank and the Godmanchester Covid 19 Mutual Aid Group, who have volunteers and street coordinators in your area. All these efforts are also supported by your District and County Councils. We thank them all.

Help and Support

If you need help and support (e.g. essential shopping, prescriptions collected, or a friendly phone call) contact either of the two Godmanchester-based groups:

Vulnerable Persons

If you have had a letter from the NHS indicating that you should be shielding you must still register on NHS website (https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus-extremely-vulnerable). Please check if you know anyone to whom this applies.

Housing Concerns

The Government have asked landlords, mortgage companies and banks to give people a three month 'payment holiday' and they have banned evictions – you can find out more on the Government's website:
