Notification of A1307 work – Hemingford

I am writing to inform you that we plan to undertake necessary work to install reinforcement plates on the Rideaway bridge over the A1307 near Hemingford.

The work is planned to start on **Friday 3 September** and is programmed to take approximately **2 weeks**. Should there be a requirement to significantly re-programme the work, a further notification will be issued.

Traffic restrictions

To minimise the impact on local communities and motorists, we will only divert traffic from the A1307 onto local roads where absolutely necessary. Where this is required, we have liaised with Cambridgeshire County Council to agree the most reasonable route.

The following closures will be in place.

- **Closure of A1307 eastbound** between junction 24 and 26 from **8pm Friday 3 September to 6am Monday 6 September** and from **8pm Friday 10 September to 6am Monday 13 September (Diagram A)**
- **Closure of the Rideaway bridge** over the A1307 from **8pm Friday 3 September to 6am Monday 20 September (Diagram B)**

Please note these works are subject to weather conditions and dates may change, notices onsite will provide the most up to date information.

We have included diversion maps for these closures at the end of this letter.

Access and disruption

Access for emergency vehicles will be allowed at all times.

Due to the nature of the works being carried out, noise and light disturbance is unavoidable. We will however attempt to keep this to a minimum. Please accept our apologies in advance of any inconvenience that is caused whilst work is in progress.

Safety

Your safety is important to us, as is the safety of our operatives working on site. We would be grateful if you could observe signs and restrictions in place as any unauthorised access to the site creates a serious risk to safety of everyone involved.

Our roads remain open and we will continue to maintain the network, ensuring that life-saving medicine, equipment, supplies and healthcare staff can travel to where they are needed most.

All our sites have strict safeguarding measures to prevent the spread of COVID19 and none of our sites are open to the public.

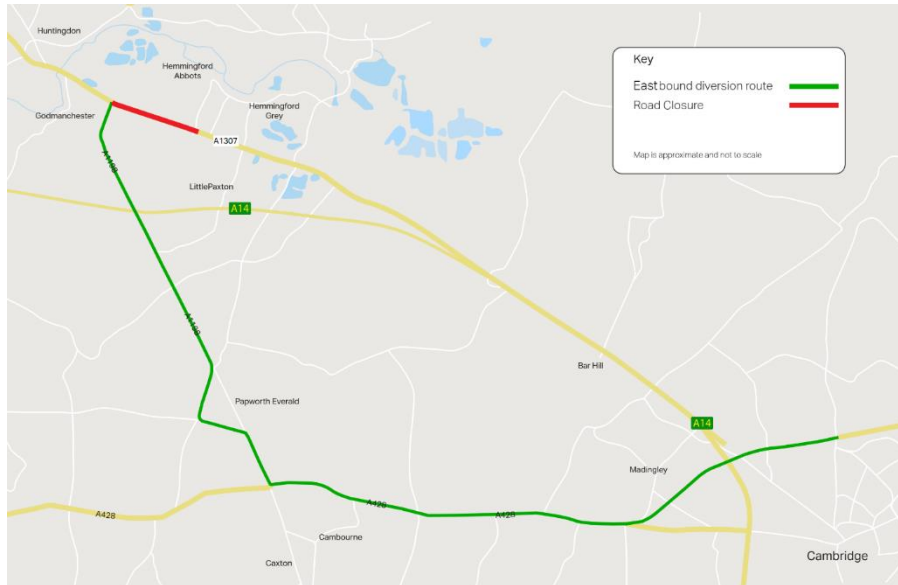

Closure of A1307 eastbound between junction 24 and 26 from 8pm Friday 3 September to 6am Monday 6 September and from 8pm Friday 10 September to 6am Monday 13 September.



Drivers heading towards the A14 eastbound

Follow the hollow square symbol

- Exit the A1307 at junction 24 for Godmanchester
- At the roundabout take the third exit onto the A1198
- Continue on the A1198 to the A428
- At Caxton Gibbet roundabout take the first exit onto the A428 towards Cambridge
- Continue onto the A14 eastbound at junction 31

Drivers heading towards the M11 southbound

Follow the above diversion then:

- Exit the A14 at junction 32
- At the roundabout take the fourth exit to re-join the A14 in the westbound direction
- At junction 31 take the slip road to join the M11 southbound

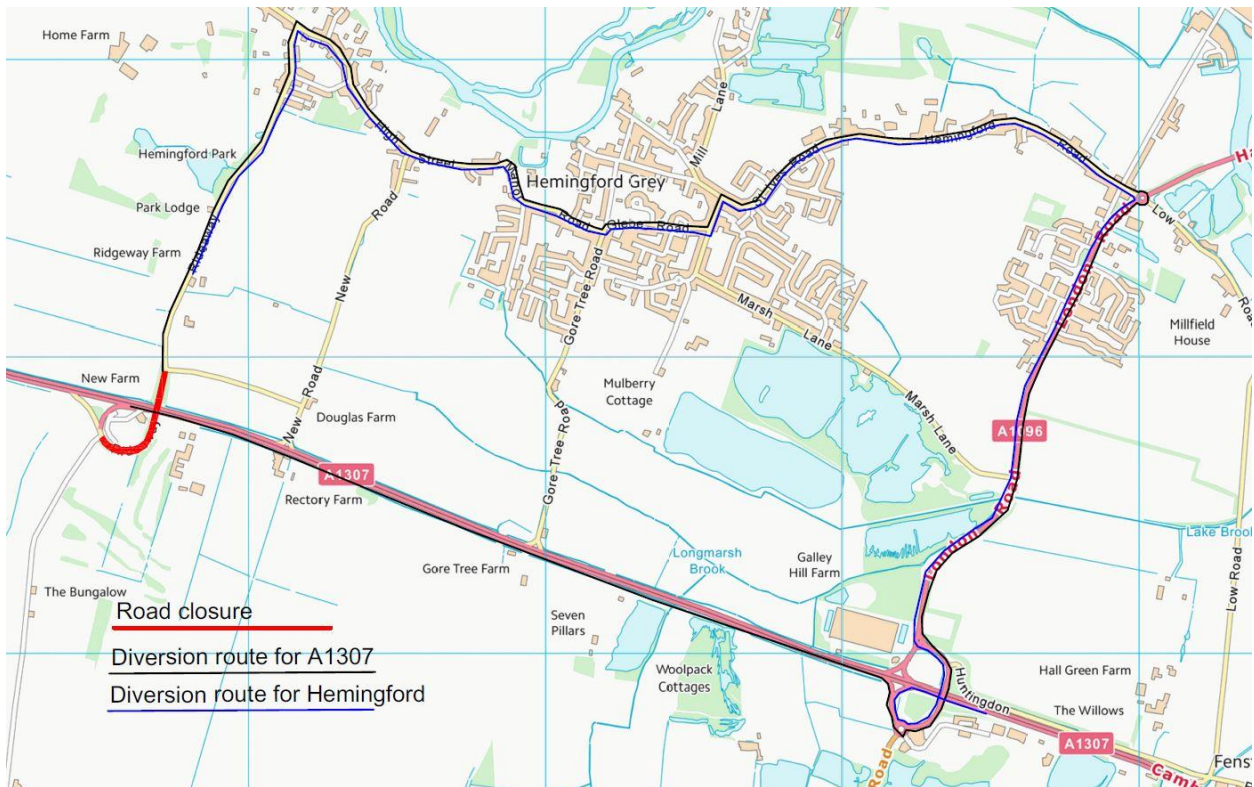
Local Traffic for junctions 25 to 30

Follow the above diversion then:

- Exit the A14 at junction 32
- At the roundabout take the fourth exit to re-join the A14 in the westbound direction
- At junction 31 take the slip road to stay on the A14 westbound
- Exit the A14 at Swavesey to use the A1307
- For the Hemingfords use junction 26

Closure of the Rideaway bridge over the A1307 from 8pm Friday 3 September to 6am Monday 20 September



Drivers from Hemingford Abbots to A1307 East

Access from New Road to the A1307 eastbound will be open as normal, including during the closures of the A1307 shown in Diagram A

Drivers from Hemingford Abbots to A1307 West

- Follow High Street/Hemingford Road eastbound up to the roundabout and take the third exit onto London Road
- Head onto St Ives Road and take the fifth exit to join the A1307 in the westbound direction

Drivers from A1307 East to the Hemingfords

Refer to Diagram A

Drivers from A1307 West to the Hemingfords

- Exit the A1307 at junction 26 for St Ives, note this is one junction ahead of the closure. At the roundabout take the first exit onto A1096 St Ives Road
- At the next roundabout take the first exit onto Hemingford Road
- For Hemingford Abbots turn left onto Pound Road and turn right onto Glebe Road
- Turn left onto Braggs Lane and then right onto Manor Road
