**21/150 BUSINESS REPORT**

Huntingdonshire District Council (HDC) had announced a short-notice opportunity to apply for Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) funds. Cllr CONBOY presented a paper and suggested that Council might be minded to apply for £45,000 towards the ongoing Nursery Project.

Cllr G WILSON asked why the Council were only bidding for £45,000 and not more. Cllr CONBOY advised that Council was obliged to contribute some of its own funds under the terms of other Grants already received for the Nursery Project and the level of the request was felt to be commensurate.

Cllr TAPLIN asked if the Council were successful would it affect a future allocation. Cllr CONBOY advised that applications could be submitted over two rounds. The pot would be eroded by applications sent in in round one and there would be less available for the second round.

Cllr CONBOY proposed that Council applied for £45,000 in CIL Round One. Cllr HYAMS seconded the proposal. All were in favour and it was so **resolved**.
