Memorial Trees and Benches

The following procedure should be followed by anyone wishing to apply for a Tree and or Bench Memorial within Godmanchester. It should be read in conjunction with the site plans and tree planting schedule shown in Appendix 1 & 3.

Town Council Policy: Tree and Bench Memorials

The Town Council manages the cemeteries in the Town and offers burial plots and places for the interment and scattering of ashes. We are often approached by families and loved ones who wish to find a way of remembering those who have died through the placement of a memorial – a tree or a bench – within the Town on the Town Council's land¹.

Memorial Trees

The Town Council would be pleased to accept the donation of memorial trees on its land, where land is available. Depending on the location preferred (from the list of sites available) those wishing for a tree memorial will, where possible, have choice from a short-list of suitable trees for the site. The cost of the tree will be specified at the time of providing the list and a choice of possible locations will be identified. The planting and establishing of the tree will be organised by the Council **in conjunction with local volunteers**: those arranging the tree are welcome to attend. Whilst every effort will be taken to ensure that the tree is established and grows, the Council will not be held liable for any replacement. Once the tree memorial is accepted on the Council's land it becomes the property of the Council, who will then manage it along with all the other trees on the site. It will not be possible to have a plaque identifying the memorial tree as the Council's intention is that in time it becomes part of the Town landscape and take its place amongst the other trees around it².

Benches

The Town Council would be pleased to accept the donation of memorial benches on its land where land and sites are available. Depending on the location preferred (from the list of sites available) those wishing for a bench memorial will be **advised on the choice of designs that the Council has agreed as suitable for that location**: benches are made from recycled water durable materials in locations where flooding is likely with a choice of traditional style park benches and picnic benches depending on available sites. The cost of the bench will be specified at the time of providing the list and a choice of possible locations will be identified. The purchase and installation of the bench will be organised by the Council. Whilst every effort will be taken to ensure that the bench is retained in good order, the Council will not be held liable for any replacement required should it be damaged. Once the bench memorial is accepted on the Council's land it becomes the property of the Council, who will then manage it along with all the other street and park furniture on the site. It will be possible to have a small metal plaque identifying the memorial bench which will remain on the bench for as long

as bench is serviceable: these will be ordered at the time of purchasing the bench and the Clerk will need to approve the wording.

Appendix 1

Sites for Memorials 2019 – 2023

Memorial benches and trees shall be positioned to maximize the benefit and development of the park(s) but the Council will attempt to accommodate the wishes of the applicants. The Council will limit the number of memorial benches in particular areas so that they shall not detract from the prime purpose of the park. Therefore, the size and location of the park shall limit the number permitted. The Council reserves the right to refuse applications on this basis.

The Recreation Ground

Trees

Tree memorials will be mostly offered around the perimeter of the Recreation Ground unless replacement trees are required. Tree species will be water tolerant which are in keeping with the character of site and it's propensity to flood. **None currently available.**

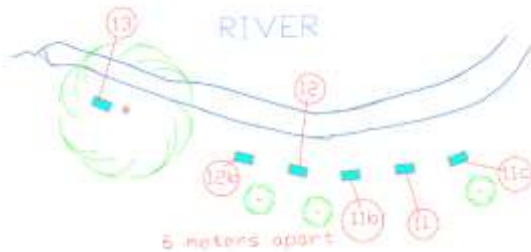
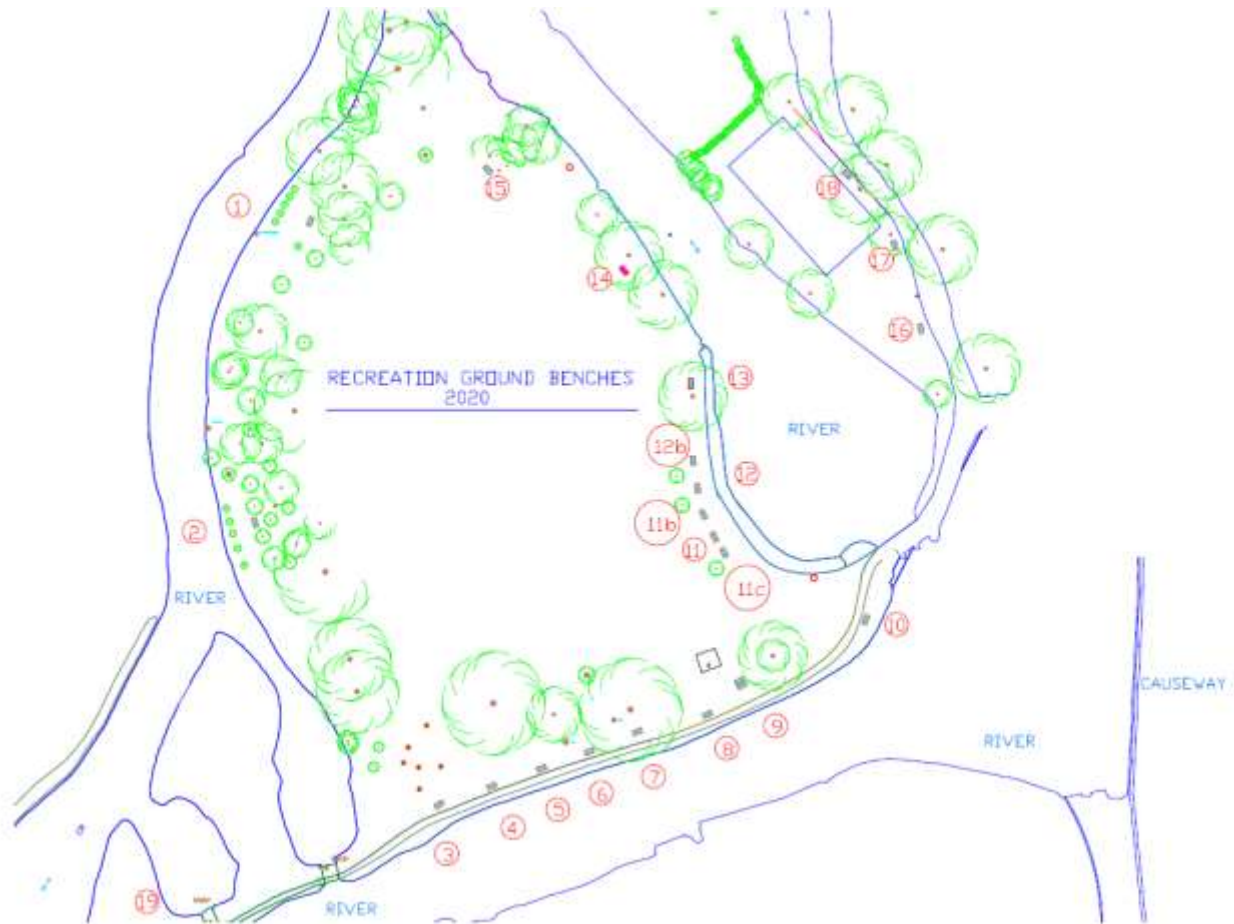

Trees

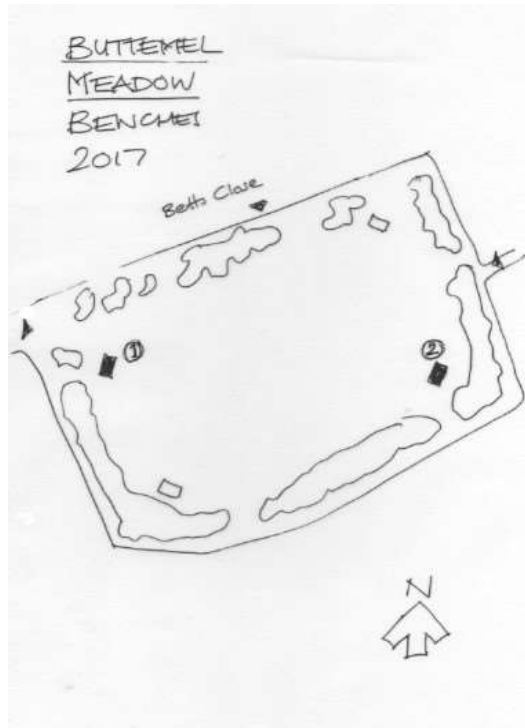
Tree memorials will be mostly offered around the perimeter of the Buttermel unless replacement trees are required. Tree species will generally be from a list of native or orchard trees which are in keeping with the character of site.

Benches will be either styles 'A' or 'B'.

Tree memorials will be mostly offered around the perimeter of the Judith's Field unless replacement trees are required. Tree species will generally be from a list of native or orchard trees which are in keeping with the character of site.

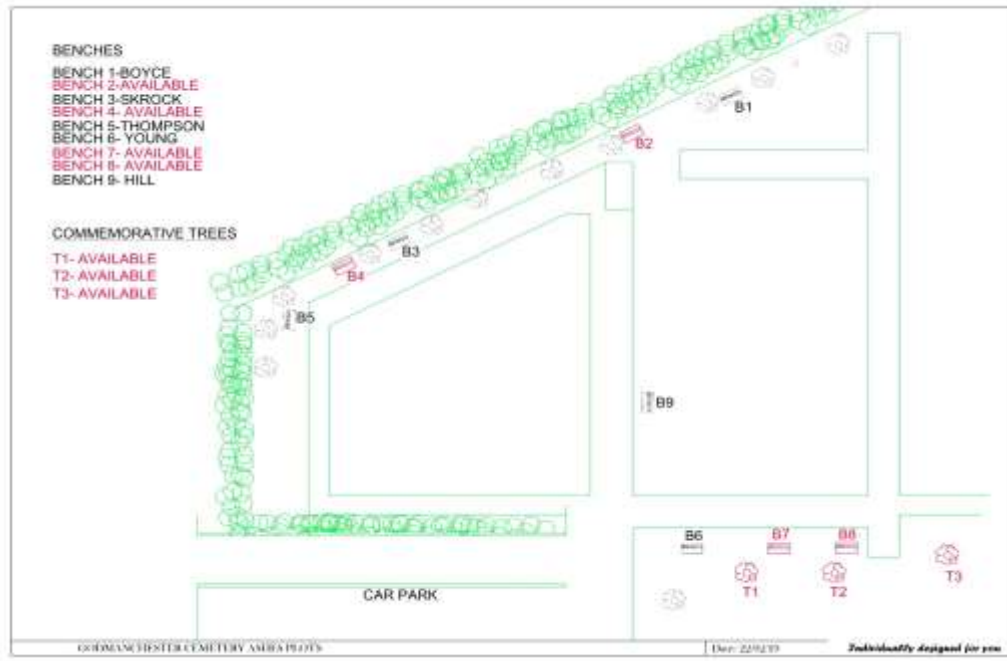

Tree memorials will be offered as indicated on the drawing below. Tree species will generally be from a list of native or orchard trees which are in keeping with the character of site.

Plaques for benches

Plaques will be metal and will be brass or silver in colour, measuring **either 150mm x 50mm or 200mm x 50mm**. The inscription is restricted to 'In (Loving) Memory of the name for the person and the dates of birth and death.

Appendix 2

Lease Period

All memorials are based on a 10-year lease and can be renewed after this period if the applicant wishes. The fee covers the purchase, delivery and installation of the memorial, together with the ongoing repair and maintenance for the 10-year period.

The Council reserves the right to remove any bench or tree, which in its opinion is damaged or beyond economical repair.

Process

Once an application has been received and location agreed, the Town Council shall arrange for the purchase and planting/installation of the preferred memorial.

The Council reserves the right to remove any memorial benches or trees that have been damaged and are in view of the Council beyond economical repair.

The Council accepts no liability for damage to any memorial benches or trees from vandals, third parties or whilst the Council carries out routine maintenance in the park.

The Council will not grant applications for memorial benches to pets.

No additional mementoes e.g. vases, statues, flowers, wreaths, balloons or other ornamentation etc., shall be permitted on or around the bench. These shall be removed without reference to the original applicant.

Payment

Payment is required with every completed application form. Cheques should be made payable to Godmanchester Town Council.

Conditions

Godmanchester Town Council reserves the right to plant trees and install benches where suitable, but will, where appropriate, accommodate requests.

Once planted/installed, the tree/bench cannot be repositioned or removed from the site. However, should a tree or bench become unsafe, Godmanchester Town Council reserves the right to remove immediately in the interest of health and safety until repairs or replacement can take place.

Godmanchester Town Council will maintain responsibility for the memorial and associated plaque during the 10-year lease period. This will include any preservation, treatment, repair works and replacement of the memorial where required due to fair wear and tear.

Existing Benches

While every reasonable effort will be made to contact the original owners of private benches, the Town Council will assume ownership for any existing benches that are privately owned and maintain and remove accordingly.
