Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under all relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to:

Implement a 20mph zone in the town of Godmanchester – starting/ending on:

- The Avenue (B1044), at a point 39m north of its junction with Park Ln
- West St (B1043), at a point 384m southwest of its junction with The Causeway (B1043) and Old Court Hall
- Silver St, at a point 22m south of its junction with Duck End; Cambridge Rd (B1044), at a point 139m east of its junction with Meadow Way
- London Rd, at a point 142m southeast of its junction with Martin Cl.
